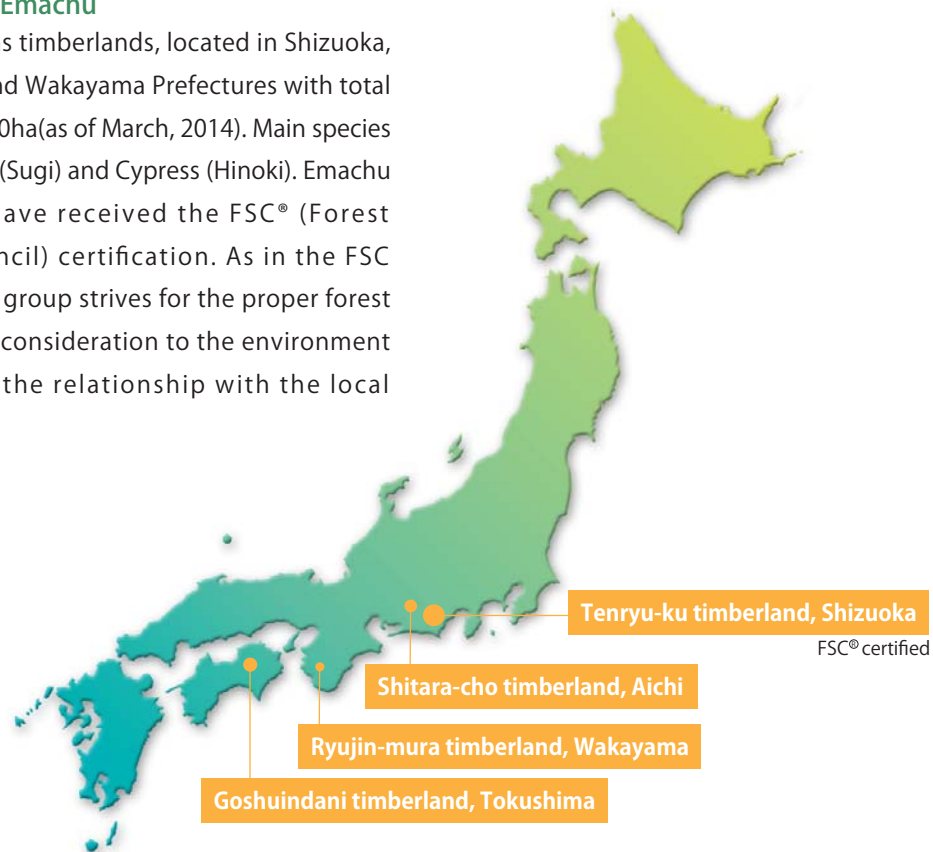


Timberlands Business

Japan is a world eminent forest country, where two thirds of the land is covered by forests. Forest products are known as renewable resources and have aspects of public interest, including water conservation, supporting our lives. Emachu group practices sustainable recycling-oriented forest management and aims at leaving beautiful forests for 100 years and beyond.

Forests owned by Emachu

Emachu group owns timberlands, located in Shizuoka, Aichi, Tokushima and Wakayama Prefectures with total area exceeding 1,500ha(as of March, 2014). Main species are Japanese Cedar (Sugi) and Cypress (Hinoki). Emachu group's forests have received the FSC® (Forest Stewardship Council) certification. As in the FSC principles, Emachu group strives for the proper forest management with consideration to the environment while respecting the relationship with the local community.



Forests have multilateral features such as cultivating water resources and preserving the global environment and biodiversity. Emachu group will continue forest management, taking into consideration these characteristics.



From log harvesting to manufacturing laminated lumber and pre-cutting, Emachu group works to maximize the value of its forests. In the same time, Emachu group works to preserve its beautiful timberland for the long future.
